<p>Violation #44. Equipment & linens: stored, dried, & handled Observed grease accumulation in both oven. Clean ovens. (Corrected on Site)</p> <p>Observed multiple inoperable refrigerators. Refrigerator number PC553377, 0980739, PC 636657, and walk in refrigerator number 1-167E. Service or replace refrigerators.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Utensils and equipment must be cleaned, sanitized and air dried prior to storage. Utensils, equipment, and linens must be properly cleaned and stored.</p>
<p>Violation #49. Non-food contact surfaces clean Observed grease accumulation in both oven. Clean ovens. (Corrected on Site)</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Non-food contact surfaces shall be kept clean and free of an accumulation of dust, dirt, food residue, and other debris.</p>
<p>Violation #56. Ventilation & lighting Observed two inoperable light bulbs in refrigerators. Replace light bulbs. Observed multiple inoperable light bulbs in cooking area. Replace inoperable lights.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.</p>
